GENERAL INFORMATION

- Following a complicated implementation, MobileTrak went live on July 1. MobileTrak is expected to provide more accurate response time data since the time stamps do not require a dispatcher to push a button or depress an "enter" key.
- After the burn ban lifts, Benton County wants to conduct a prescribed burn. In addition, the City is pursuing burns at two parks and is working with ODF toward conducting a burn at the Mary's Peak watershed.

FIRE MARSHAL'S REPORT

- On June 24, one Battalion Chief and one engine responded to the report of a small vehicle fire on Owl Place. The fire was quickly extinguished and appears to have been caused by oil leakage from a small hole in the side of the engine, behind and above the oil pan.
- Fire Prevention staff have been conducting inspections of businesses located along Highway 34 (east of Corvallis) and are working with Linn County to correct some addressing issues in the Eastgate Circle complex.
- A fireworks permit was issued for a location on Carroll Drive.
