Fire Department staff have been gathering information in preparation for ECSI's upcoming study to determine whether consolidation opportunities exist between Corvallis and Albany Fire Departments.

The first phase of the City Manager recruitment process has yielded six semi-finalists:

The candidates will be in town on August 4 and 5. There will be a forum the evening of the 4th for City employees and citizens to meet the candidates & ask questions one-on-one.

Council will narrow the field to two or three who will be invited back for follow up by the the Council on August 16.
