FIRE MARSHAL'S REPORT

- 10 Plan Reviews.
- Benton County Fair is coming up.
- July's FLS inspections were completed in June.
- 1, 4th of July fireworks permit in a residential neighborhood was denied due to previous inability to control fallout. The applicant had been cautioned proper to last year's event to keep all fallout on his property. In our post-demonstration inspection, debris was found as far as 150 feet into the neighboring property.

STATION 6 LIEUTENANT'S REPORT

July Project Status

- Floors- Completed
- Generator and Fire pump – both are full of fuel and batteries checked
- HVAC filters have been replaced with the correct size (see purchase summary below). Previously purchased filters have been returned to vender and should appear as credited to the CRFPD bank card.
- Consulted with David Hobson, Groundhog LLC. Per Hobson, Septic Service has been performed recently (June) and he recommends pumping it every 2-3 years and a semi-annual maintenance schedule (every 6 months).
- Cleaning behind refrigerators, in progress. Will be thoroughly completed in conjunction with waxing of floors before open house.
- Inspected station phones.
- Fields: Board has indicated that they will find a new contractor for a mowing date before Open House (October 1).
- Well pump serviced by Stutzman Services on 07/20/16.
- Backflows checked on 07/10/16, found leaking valve in bay mechanical room. Was repaired by Stutzman Services 07/20/16.
- All but 1 irrigation zone of broken irrigation lines in the north yard were fixed 07/20/16 by Stutzman Services. They also discovered that there is a leak in one of the main lines from the well pump to the irrigation system, causing one of the well pumps to run continuously. As such, they have left the irrigation system off (to protect the well pump) and will email the Board with repair recommendations.
- Valley Fire Control (Mike) has been scheduled to service extinguishers (on his schedule) during the month of July.
