- 7 of the RRVs are state licensed EMTs (the 3 other RRVs and our CV are enrolled in a Winter Term EMT Course)
- Staff anticipates numerous vacancies being created through 2017/2018 as a result of regional hiring.
- CV Tony O'Donahue is making steady progress working through the Apparatus Operator Training Program.
- Nick Pozzesi and Cole Schneider are close to completing the Tender Operator Training Program and have started the Crew Leader Training Program.
- 6 of the RRVs who are EMTs have begun the ~ 4 month process to obtain their Standing Orders.
