### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- The Volunteer interviews and physical ability test were completed successfully by 23 candidates. Conditional offers have been accepted.
- The Firefighter/EMT interviews have been held, and the physical ability test has been administered. Seven conditional offers have been accepted.

### **FIRE MARSHAL'S REPORT**

- One wildland fire occurred in the District during June of 2015:
  - June 14, 2015; approximately 3:31 p.m., 900 Block of NW Davis Meadow Place (The fire was not called in to 911; BC Loudon saw the plume of smoke and investigated.)
  - One engine, two tenders, four brush trucks, one Chief Officer, and one Fire Prevention Officer responded to a wildland fire that was approximately ¼ acre and involved several large fir trees, with flames up the trunks and into branches 50 feet above the ground. Oregon Department of Forestry also responded.
  - The fire was caused by someone attempting to "make coals" on his neighbor's property for a Dutch oven he planned to use. He was later cited for reckless burning.
  - The fire was extinguished, and a fire watch was established.

### **Special Notes**

The station will be down to seven interns for the next few months until qualified Intern candidates are identified and trained. With the departures (Norlander, Lewis, and Boatwright), we will be losing all but one crew leader. Training has been focused on Crew Leader development and Tender Operation. I would anticipate several station closures every month until staffing levels increase. Interns Sankovitz, Tesdal, Stuck, and Kidd are all currently being trained as Crew Leaders. All Interns have started the initial training to become Tender Operators.
