Well Project - Underway. Water problems have run through Alex. Plans are in place if project takes longer than

expected with filling the holding tank from mobile water supply companies. Drinking water purchased to have on-hand in case of short notice shutdowns.

Station Beds/Blinds – Working with Tony, beds on-order and blind will cost approx. \$5000 to replace in all dorms, when on-sale. I have been advised by Home Depot that sales occur frequently. Once approved to purchase, I will contact Home Depot and make the purchase.
